Mr. Duncan leads the KPMG Washington National Tax State and Local Tax group. Prior to moving to KPMG in July 2008, Mr. Duncan spent the previous 20 years as Executive Director of the Federation of Tax Administrators, the association representing the principal state revenue collection agencies in each of the 50 states, D.C., and New York City. He also served five years as Secretary of the Kansas Department of Revenue. Prior to that, he was the Assistant Director of the Kansas Division of the Budget. He has held positions with South Dakota state government, the Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations and the National Governors' Association. Mr. Duncan received New York University's Outstanding Achievement in State and Local Taxation Award in December 2006 and was awarded the IRS Commissioner's Award in June 2008. He was cited as "The Most Influential Person on the Planet in State and Local Tax" by State Tax Notes in 2008.

He is also a member of the NYU SALT Institute Advisory Board, the Paul Hartman SALT Symposium Advisory Board, and the New England SALT Forum Board of Trustees and Advisory Board.
