

Bruce J. Fort is Senior Counsel for the Multistate Tax Commission. Prior to joining the Commission in 2007, Mr. Fort was a staff attorney and Special Assistant Attorney General for the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department for 16 years. He has co-authored numerous briefs before the U.S. Supreme Court and state appellate courts on state tax matters. Mr. Fort's additional duties for the Commission include staffing uniformity committee projects, audit support, and conducting training programs for state attorneys and auditors on corporate income tax, nexus principles and litigation techniques. Mr. Fort is a frequent presenter at state and local tax conferences, including the Paul J.
