Stacy Gibson is an assistant commissioner at the Tennessee Department of Revenue. She is responsible for managing the Department's Audit Division and also serves as Revenue's liaison with the Department of Economic and Community Development, where she consults on a variety of tax incentive and related matters. Stacy also was previously responsible for the Department's Policy group and oversaw its transition to becoming its own division, served as a member of the TR³ Project Executive Board during the implementation of Tennessee's modernized tax system, and continues to serve as the Department's coordinator for the state's Alternative Workspace Solutions ("AWS") initiative. Prior to her role as assistant commissioner, Stacy served as the director of the Audit Division beginning in 2004. The division continues to be the Department's largest and includes well over 300 employees across the State of Tennessee and the country. She first joined the Department in 1999 as an administrative hearing officer and transitioned into directing that office. Prior to her time at Revenue, she served as an assistant attorney general in the Attorney General's Tax Division and worked in private law practice. She is a graduate of the University of Kentucky, Vanderbilt University Law School, and the Tennessee Government Executive Institute ("TGEI"). Over the years, Stacy has volunteered in several capacities in her community and is a former president of Rediscover East! Stacy currently serves on the Finance Committee for Ascension St. Thomas and lives in East Nashville with her husband and son and two very spoiled dogs.
